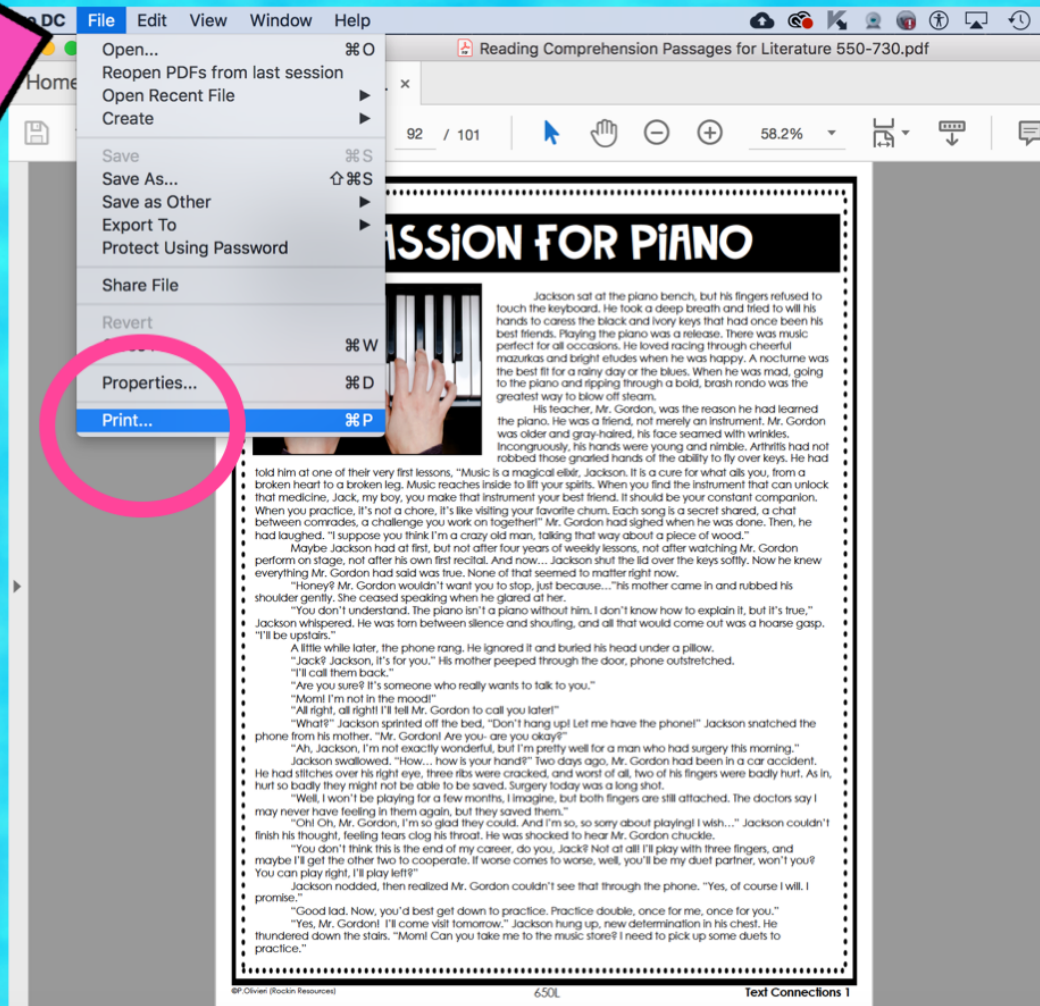

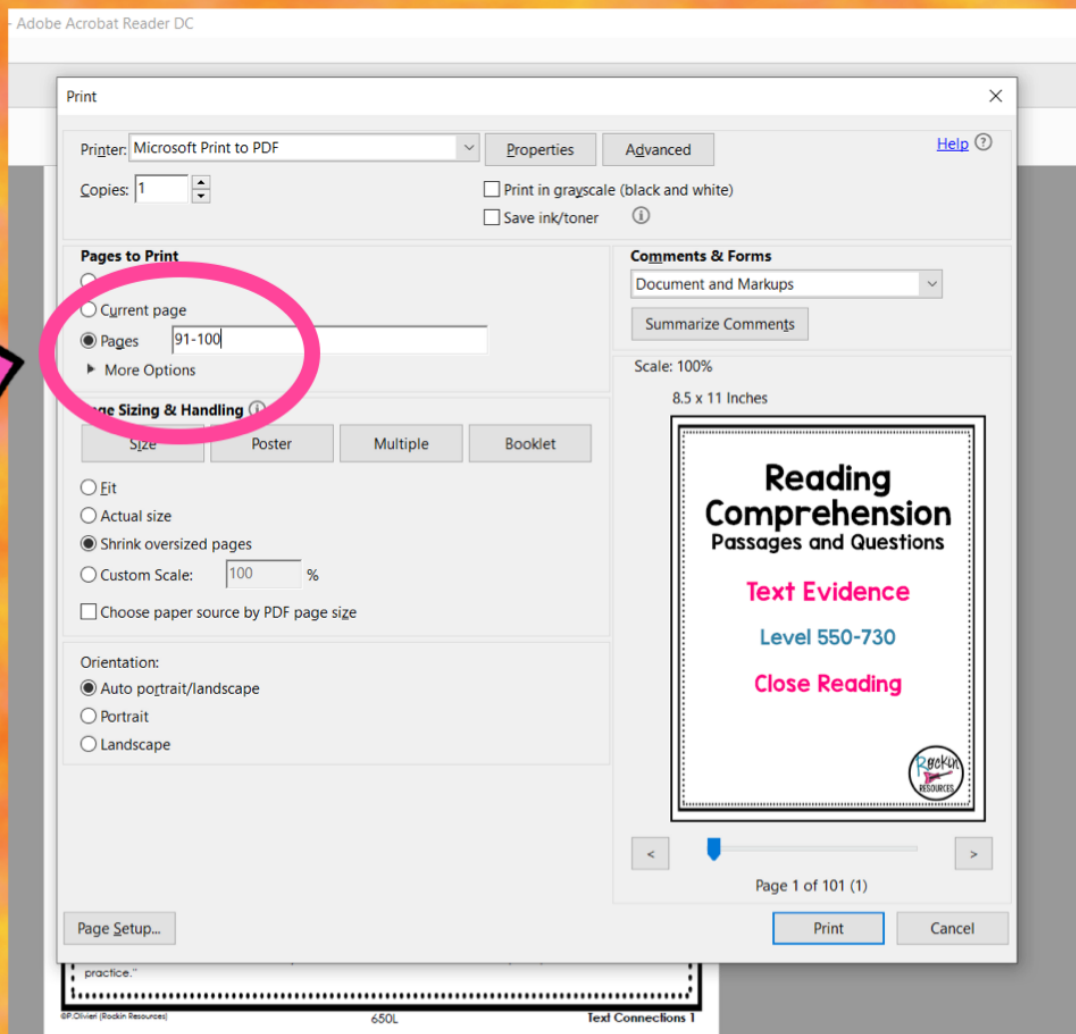

1. Summarize the current relationship between Jackson and his teacher, Mr. Gordon.
2. Why does Jackson worry about the extent of Mr. Gordon's influence?
3. Describe how Jackson uses music as a way to connect to his teacher.
4. How did Jackson's opinion of Mr. Gordon change over time?
5. What text clues show you that Jackson doesn't view his piano teacher as only a teacher?
6. How can you infer that not only Jackson, but also his mother, are concerned about Mr. Gordon?
7. Describe Mr. Gordon's attitude after his surgery.
8. What evidence is used in the text to show that even after his accident, Mr. Gordon still inspires and influences Jackson as a musician?
9. Compare and contrast Jackson's attitude toward practicing from the beginning of the passage to the end of the passage.
10. **Writing Prompt:** Mr. Gordon shows that he is not willing to let a setback ruin his career and his passion for the piano. What characteristics do you think are most important for someone to have in order to overcome obstacles and pursue their dreams? Write an essay that explores at least three character traits needed for resiliency, and support your statements with facts and examples. Use additional paper if needed for a thorough response.

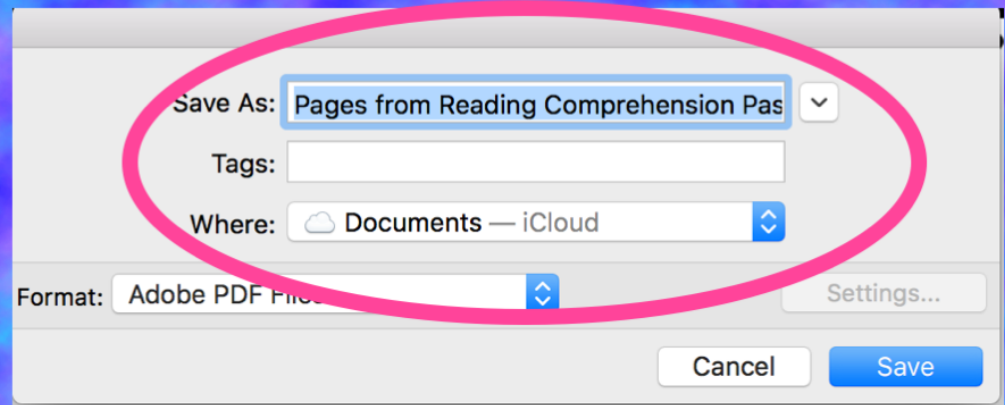
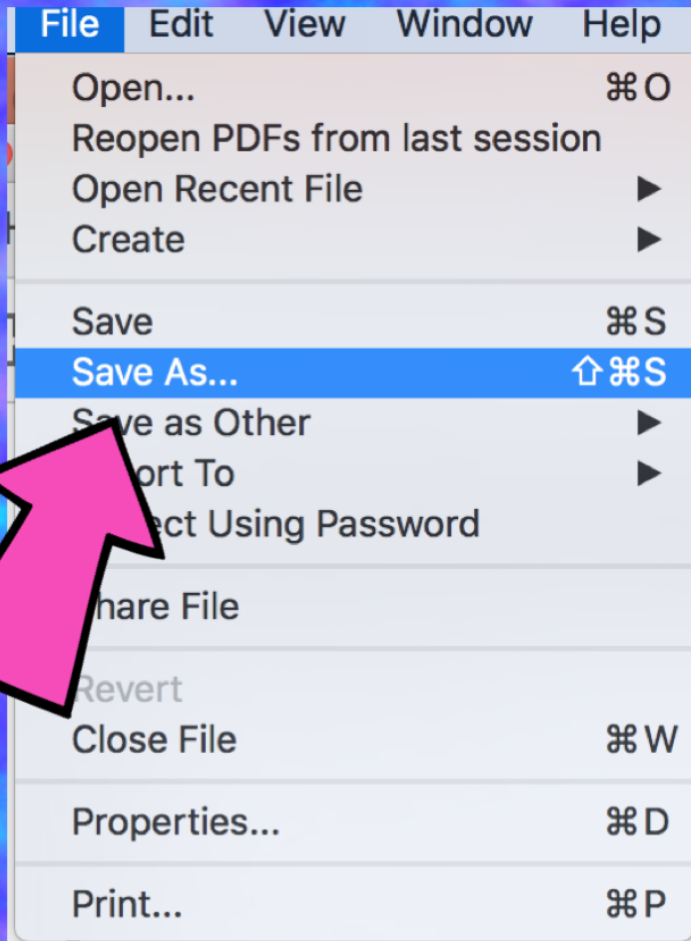
